
2022 Tour Results

The Tour drew over 6,000 attendees, with approximately \$451,000 in art sales.

Public Satisfaction: Survey data indicates a high satisfaction rate and 93% of the attendees plan to attend again in 2023. Nearly half of survey respondents purchased food & drink and visited local businesses.

Artist Satisfaction: Artist survey data indicates a high satisfaction rate, and the majority intend to be on tour in 2023.


Artist Sales During the Tour





I think I even utilized a Friday this year.


Tour Attendee Navigation Methods


